Eligibility Requirements:

1. Student must be graduating high school senior attending Spring Grove Area Senior High School.
2. Student must be planning to attend full-time at a four year post-secondary school with classes starting in the fall immediately following high school graduation.

Required Materials:

- Completed VFW Post 5265 Scholarship Application
- Official High School Transcript for current year
- SAT and/or ACT scores
- FAFSA: Only submit copy of front page of FAFSA form showing the EFC number
- Acceptance letter from the accredited school you will attend.
- (2) Letters of Recommendation: non-family member, teacher, employer, etc.

Additional Information: Scholarship application and supporting documents are due in the guidance office no later than deadline listed below, late applications can not be accepted. Scholarships will be awarded at the high school's Senior Awards Night.
